At the time the Equipment was reviewed the Airwave Reference System was configured as follows:

Airwave interface Software version	Airwave System was built to baseline R7.1.1 SPU

The concession review conducted on the Equipment suggests that it will not adversely impact the Airwave Network when used or connected (as it had been configured and tested during Certification and in accordance with the test specification listed below). The concession assessment was limited to minimum Conformance in accordance with the latest specification and no specific functionality or performance of the product exercised unless specified below or in the test report.

Key Observation/Comments:

- 1. This concession certificate has been issued as a result of minor change to the terminal driver software. The assessment was based on information provided by APD on the 3 & 5 July covering these changes.
- 2. In the original conformance testing of the application it was noted that terminal TX timer was set for 10 seconds. This is considered to be short and therefore it is recommended that this is extended to 20 seconds for normal deployment. It was also noted that there was no indication

of successful delivery of short data messages or delivery failure is presented to the console operator.
