1. No indication/confirmation to the operator of success or failure of Short Data Message delivery to the radio user..

2. After a failure and restoration of the link between the ICCS and the Network Access terminal it is necessary to reselect the talkgroup in use before a call can be made. This does not impact operator upon receiving calls from another radio user.
3. Testing was conducted using the Radio Connected Dispatch Console Generic Test Plan Iss 1.
